Second Period, Notice of Incompleteness**

Mr. Courtney:

On September 3, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received a request for a Second 5-Year Period of Temporary Cessation (TC) for the Coyote Ridge, File No. M-2000-052. Pursuant to Rule 1.13.5(3)(c) a “demonstration of continued commitment to conduct mining operations at the site by the end of the second five (5) year period” is required to process a request for second consecutive TC. No such demonstration was received. Please provide a written commitment to resume mining prior to the end of the second 5-Year Period of Temporary Cessation and, if that proves to be infeasible, commit to starting final reclamation prior to the end of the second 5-year period of temporary cessation.
