Perhaps one of you guys can write a short letter and have a representative of the land company sign it.



Because ponds at the North Thompson Creek Mine are to remain as permanent impoundments, provisions for sound future maintenance by the permittee or landowner must be made, per Rule 3.03.1(3)(c). Please provide to the Division a letter from the landowner, North Thompson – Four Mile Mineral & Land Corporation, stating that they intend to continue to maintain the ponds to prevent pollution of North Thompson Creek in the future.
