Hello. I received a Sep 6, 2021 USPS letter from Loveland Ready Mix stating Loveland Ready Mix "has started the permitting process for a new sand and gravel mine on our property across from you." (I live at the Mad Russian Golf Course.)

Their "first informational meeting" was Sep 14, 2021 evening. I could not attend and emailed the letter-contact Stephanie Fancher-English on Sep 16 2021 of Loveland Ready Mix stating this.

Stephanie said she'd send me docs about the meeting but I've received nothing yet as of Sep 23, 2021.

So my questions to you are:

- 1) Is there a conduit for me as a Mad Russian Golf Course homeowner to keep abreast and comment directly into the permitting process?
- 2) I have yet to receive any info or maps after the Loveland Ready Mix Sep 6 2021 letter and my inquiries with Stephanie Fancher-English. Can you send maps and applications to me?

I went on the Weld County Property Assessors site. The Loveland Ready Mix properties are indeed right on a tiny sliver of land south of the railroad tracks and north of the Big Thompson River, directly south of the Mad Russian Golf Course and my house.

I sure hope you and Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife are aware of the two annual great blue heron nests, one annual bald eagle nest, numerous neotropical songbird nests, mule deer populations, coyote and turkey populations, numerous hawks and owls, and temporary landing areas of American White Pelicans and Sandhill Cranes along that sliver of land on the Big Thompson River riparian corridor!

I cannot believe this sliver of isolated land is being considered for a sand and gravel mine!

- 3) Can you please send me a direct link to the CDP&W person who handles this application? I do not think CDP&W knows how much wildlife is here.
