Dear Mr. Ebert,

In response for the pit not being in operation was due to Robinson not being able to open our pit because he was not in compliance with the one that he was in. We kept waiting for him to get things in line, but that never happened. Also with all the activity in our vicinity Fisher's Peak State Park, and Industrial Park where all the marijuana facilities are, we are with hopes that the trails, roads, and streets etc. would need gravel. We have been approached by large companies asking if our pit is available. They evidently are waiting for the jobs they bid on to be decided upon. At the end of the second temporary cessation, the plan is to reclaim the pit.

We are acknowledging that the initiation of the second term of temporary cessation shall be March 28, 2020, and the expiration date to be March 25, 2025.

The boundary markers are still in tack, just unfortunate Larry was not able to assist you on the day you were here due to an eye appointment in Pueblo. I will send an email with pictures and stating their locations. They have resprayed with fluorescent paint.
