The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) understands the bonding agency requires confirmation from us that separate bonds are allowed for the same permit. The Division allows this and in such cases as T.H.E Aggregate Source, it is preferred because of the split nature of the land and mineral ownership.

In order for us to track the separate warranties, it would be helpful if the following Mine Phase information was noted on the respective financial warranty corporate surety forms:
