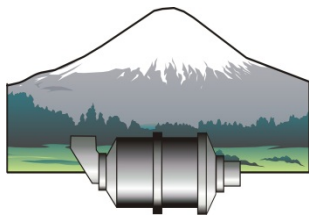

RE: Response to October 15, 2021 Correspondence

Mr. Fattor,

Union Milling Contractors (UMC) has prepared this response on behalf of CJK Milling Company LLC, the Application for the Arkansas Valley Slag Project. Responses to your request for information:

1. **Why did you not address the fact that your Certified Letter of September 8, 2021, regarding this matter, which was directed to the Sanitation District was not posted for a number of weeks?**

Response:

It was our understanding that the structural agreements were to be submitted after CDRMS acceptance of our permit application. In fact, we were to submit the Structure Agreements at the time of application. This misunderstanding was brought to our attention by Dustin Czapla at CDRMS and we have appropriately addressed this issue.

2. **Within my letter of October 1, I requested the copy of your engineering evaluation demonstrating that the structures of the Leadville Sanitation District will not be damaged by the proposed activities. As a response, you stated that the document is currently being prepared. If it is not prepared, how can you now conclude that the Leadville Sanitation District cannot be damaged by the proposed activities?**

Response:

The engineering report cannot state that we will not damage Leadville Sanitation assets. Instead, the engineering report will identify assets that could potentially be damaged in which CJK will be responsible. As per regulations, structural agreements are delivered first to property owners within 200 ft of the project for signature. If no signature is received the Engineering Report needs to be completed within 60 days from the date the Structure Agreements were mailed. Therefore, the due date for the engineering report is November 7, 2021. John Erich Rauber and Associates (CO PE number 26647) is currently working on this report. We will provide a copy once its prepared.
