Subject: Technical Revision 15 (TR-15) Addendum: Reagent Chemical Storage DRMS Permit No. M-2012-032 Revenue Mine, Ouray County, Colorado

Dear Mr. West,

Ouray Silver Mines, Inc. (OSMI) is formally requesting permission to bring containers of reagent chemicals to site before the completion of the Reagent Room to expediate commissioning of the Revenue Mill. While the Reagent Room of the Revenue Mill is being constructed, OSMI proposes to bring reagent chemicals to site in the quantities below and to store them to the Flotation Gallery of the mill for use in the commissioning process. The quantities of reagents described in the table below are sufficient for roughly one month of processing. Sodium metabisulfite is consumed at a slightly faster rate than other reagents and two totes of this reagent might be used before the Reagent Room is complete. Reagents would be applied at the same dosing rates as proposed in Technical Revision #15. All environmental controls for the Flotation Gallery of the Mill Tunnel are in place. Once the Reagent Room of the mill is complete the chemicals will be stored as described in Technical Revision #15.
