Dear Mr. Mellage,

The Division received your above referenced response to the Compliance Problems cited in the Division's inspection report that was conducted on September 29, 2021. The status of the corrective actions in regard to the cited problems are as follows:

Problem: The mine identification sign was not legible at the entrance of the mine site. This is a problem for failure to post a mine identification sign as required by Section 3.1.12(1) of the rule.

Corrective action: The Operator shall submit a photo documentation that a proper sign has been posted by the corrective action date.

The Division received photo documentation of the entrance sign post at the site and the problem is considered resolved.
