Dear Mr. Weldon:

On May 19, 2020 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division), approved the 112c Conversion Application (CN-1) for the North River Gravel Pit Extension. The application required an additional bond amount of \$227,862.00 to be posted prior to Permit Issuance. No financial warranty adjustments have been made to date.

On October 12, 2021 the Division received your written notice to withdraw the permit conversion application (CN-1) and for the site to enter into final reclamation as a 110c permitted site. The Division has accepted your withdrawal notice and the revision has been terminated. The above mentioned site shall remain permitted at 8.85 acres with a required bond amount of \$25,900.

At this time the Division believes that the site is under bonded based on observations from the April 27, 2021 inspection and the Divisions May 4, 2021 reclamation cost estimate. The Division will allow up to 90 days to complete initial reclamation activities before recalculating the reclamation cost estimate. Provide the Division with supporting documentation of reclamation progress made by Tuesday, February 8, 2022. At that time the Division will recalculate the Financial Warranty and adjust the bond as necessary. If no documentation is provided, then the Division will issue a surety increase in the amount of \$54,448 for a total bond amount of \$80,348 to be held as previously calculated and discussed.
