OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Scott Pottorffs and Dana Cline, representing Highbury Resources, and Kyle Turley, representing DOE, were present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Mineral Joe Claims site is located approximately nine miles west of Naturita and accessed from EE19 Road. The site is a 110d operation that includes a total of 9.5 permitted acres.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

There has been no recent activity at this site. Conditions appear unchanged from previous inspections. The Duggan adit is secured with a locking gate. The office building and compressor shed remain dilapidated due to site inactivity. Stormwater control structures appeared maintained and functional.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection. Final reclamation has not yet commenced.
