OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted in response to surety release request submitted by the operator. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The Dotsero Quarry is located approximately 1.5 miles northeast of Dotsero and accessed from Trail Gulch Road. The site is a 112c operation that includes an affected area of 13 acres.

The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$12,373.51 for this site.

The mine identification sign was in place and adequate.

Reclamation has been completed at the site. The areas disturbed by mining have been graded to blend well with the surrounding topography. No significant erosion or stability issues were noted. Little to no topsoil exists at the site so vegetation is sparse, but similar in extent of coverage to that of the surrounding area. The site sees significant atv traffic and trails are scattered throughout the site.

This inspection verified that necessary reclamation tasks have been completed by the operator.

No problems or violations were noted.
