It has been recently reported that on November 5, 2021, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) issued a cease and desist order to Grand Island Resources, LLC for repeated violations of their current discharge permit for the Cross and Caribou Mines located above Boulder and Nederland, in the western Boulder County Headwaters. Despite charges of failing to comply with their existing permit, Grand Island Resources looks to expand their operations.

The request to expand their operations raises grave concerns for the local community and community at large as Grand Island Resources has already failed to comply with their permit at the existing operational level. According to reports, the pollutants listed in violation for exceeding discharge levels include lead, copper, zinc, silver and cadmium.

There is also the concern of moving large truck loads of material down Caribou rd. Caribou rd, is very rough, narrow, dusty, and dangerous, especially in the winter. I have experienced careless, high speed driving by employees, and dangerous maneuvers of their equipment on the rd.

I would like to see this mining operation completely closed down for their negligence regarding the environment and the associated risk to all the Boulder County residents and their wells that are down stream of the operation. The water in Coon Track Creek, Boulder Creek and Barker Reservoir are all at risk. Thank you,

The mine's discharge feeds into the drinking water for Boulder County residents, and flows through the property of hundreds of residents relying on well water for their homes. Several years of discharge reports have shown heavy metal discharge into the waterway. Daily sanctions have not been imposed, and should be, and further operations should be prohibited until it has been confirmed that ongoing discharge has ceased, and the risk to public health and safety abated. The expansion requests from this mine should not be considered or granted until such time as their current operations are lawful and the expansion is assured to pose no further risk.
