A group of 25 volunteers met on Saturday, February 20, to help clean and prep the Gilpin County Community Center for its early March re-opening. Members of Friends of the Gilpin

County Community Center (FGCCC), the 4-H Archwood and Eagle clubs, and other interested residents showed up to sanitize equipment, wipe down doors, desks, exercise equipment, mats, and other surfaces. They also washed windows and created safety signs for use throughout the building. "This was a

community effort," said Gilpin Parks & Recreation Director Gabrielle Chisholm, "and we could not have done it without everyone's help." The center, which has been closed throughout the Covid-19 pandemic, is set to reopen in early March, operating under guidelines from the state and
