## COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection of the Foidel Creek Mine; DRMS Permit No. C-1982-056, operated by Twentymile Coal, LLC. (TC). This inspection was conducted by Tabetha Lynch with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division). Stream buffer signs were checked and in place during the inspection. Historical school appeared untouched. Please not Divisions items at the 7E pad listed below.

### GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE:

At the 7E, cement drop pad, permitted by the Division under TR97, multiple structures were noted by the Division at the time of inspection. Per the operator these are temporary structures owned by the contractor for the required cement work required. However these structures are not currently accounted for within the Divisions reclamation cost estimate. **Please provide the Division with an MR including these temporary structures in the reclamation cost estimate (RCE) or provide the Division a rational on why these structures have not been included in the RCE.
