Hi Brandon,

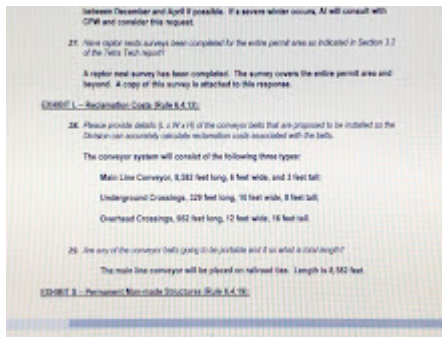

Again this would be just the portion in this amendment (permit) which does not include the additional length/run in the Wattenberg pit that travels up to their Platte Valley plant. (Where my arrow was at in the diagram).

So assuming whatever height of the railroad ties (as I was unable to find out if those were going to be set into the ground) - would presumably be the height. (??) But as I said before, what was presented to the County (and diagramed) represented a 4-5' height. Not sure if there is something new being presented there now.

Good afternoon Sherie,

Thanks for your continued information, as we appreciate your concern for deer in this area.

I have reached out to Patrick (DRMS; cc'd) and confirmed that the only action under consideration right now is the proposed new ~1.3-mile-long conveyor belt, as the other conveyor belts are already on the landscape. I also reached out to local field staff (also cc'd), and we collectively agree to continue standing by our 11/16/21 comments that this new action will not "cause significant wildlife impacts to local wildlife." Note: that doesn't mean the same thing as "no impact". However, please know that we did discuss the cumulative impacts of this project in relation to others on the landscape, especially since no other DRMS requests for comment actions are currently proposed or likely coming soon.

Therefore, if you receive anything substantive from the DRMS pre-hearing later this week and/or from the eventual county permitting process, please pass that along to us for further consideration.
