The weather was mostly clear and the site was snow covered during the inspection.

As noted in the on ground December 20, 2021 inspection; multiple structures were noted by the Division at the 7E, cement drop pad, permitted by the Division under TR97. Per the operator these are temporary structures owned by the contractor for the required cement work required. However these structures are not currently accounted for within the Divisions reclamation cost estimate. Any mine related structures (include those utilized by mine contractors) regardless of the duration of use are required to be bonded. **Please address this issue within 10 days of this inspection report, dated 1/19/22.** Aerial photos of the 7E pad are provided below.
