7East Pad Site Temporary Tent Structures

Dear Ms. Lynch:

Twentymile Coal, LLC (TC) requests CDRMS approval of a Minor Revision to our existing approved Permit for placement and reclamation of three tent structures at the 7East pad site for the underground grout pumping project. The duration of the pumping will be taking place during the winter months and therefore heat and protection from the winter conditions is warranted.

The pad location will consist of three temporary quonset style tents. The first tent will be 30' x 50' and will house the water necessary for the grout mixing and prevent it from freezing. The second tent will also be 30' x 50 and will be used to cover the flyash to protect it from snow fall and wind. The final tent is 84' x 100' and will be used to house the grout mixing plant and the daily operations of pumping the grout underground. All the tents are owned by the contractor and the maintenance and removal of the tents will be performed by the contractor once the pumping is complete.

All the tents are temporary structures and do not have foundations. The shells of the structures are a plastic material that covers the steel frames.

We appreciate your consideration, cooperation, and assistance in facilitating timely review and approval of this Minor Revision application.
