DRMS Annual Report Comments For Monogram Permit 2021

- 1. The date of last exploration was 12/13/21
- 2. An old access road will be rehabbed late spring early summer for better access
- 3. Activity at mine site is underground and surface activity is kept to a minimum to decrease visible impact
- 4. The Green Back portal has been dug out and is in the process of being rehabbed
- 5. Work continues to define and expand on resources on the Monogram Permit
- 6. Nuvemco has been directly involved in providing information and comment to various federal administrative and legislative with respect to identified critical minerals and supply chains at risk. These include, but are not limited to, the U.S. Department of Commerce, the U.S. Department of Energy, the Nuclear Fuel Working Group, and the U.S. House of Representatives. We are working to reduce U.S. reliance on foreign supply on minerals, including rare earth elements, that are part of innumerable essential products such as electric and hybrid cars, computers, military equipment, batteries, and cell phones. We are also working with academia and have been a part of newly discovered minerals in Colorado whose economic, environmental, and medical benefits are yet to be developed. All of these activities are part of the process of adding economic utility and value to our permits.
