Technical Revision to Permit-

- (1) In order to establish growth from the prior issue of vegetative growth Ames and Arnolds Ag will work together to establish permanent vegetation at the former borrow site.
- a. Import manure and spread compost over the existing area- Spring 2022
 - b. Disc the existing ground with the important compost- Spring 2022
 - c. Drill seed using Buffalo Brand Dryland Pasture Mix- Spring 2022
 - d. Maintain the growth during the Spring of 2022
 - e. Keep livestock off the borrow limits to establish a stronger vegetative growth
 - f. Request for a release of Permit Number M-2016-041 once suitable growth has taken place. Fall 2022/ Spring 2023
