Dear Mr. Azcarraga:

On November 10, 2021 the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) inspected the above mentioned pit. Hydrologic Balance and Mining Plan were both cited as an inspection problem. Corrective actions included demonstrating that the site has sufficient water rights to conduct the current operation and complete reclamation as approved. If water rights could not be demonstrated then the mining and reclamation plans would need to be revised accordingly. This information was due on February 28, 2022. On February 28, 2022 the Division received and extension request to allow the Operator to work with a water rights attorney to resolve this issue.

Your extension request is approved for an additional 60 days. Required corrective action documentation is due by May 1, 2022.
