On February 28, 2022 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Notice of Intent to Conduct Prospecting Modification application for the Miller Midwest site. Our initial review indicates that your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing. The following filing deficiencies need to be addressed before the application can be considered complete and filed:

- 1. Application Fee:** Pursuant to C.R.S. 34-32-101 et seq, an application fee of \$108.00 is required for all new or modifications to an existing Notice of Intent. The application fee was not received with your application materials. Please provide a check for \$108.00.

Per Rule 5.3.1(b) the applicant shall address all identified deficiencies within 60 days of the date of this notice. Please submit your responses to the above listed items no later than Monday May 9, 2022. If your response nor a written request for an extension is not received by May 9, 2022 your application may be denied.
