Dear Mr. Miller:

On February 28, 2022 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Notice of Intent to Conduct Prospecting Modification application for the Miller Midwest site. Further review indicates that your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing. The following filing deficiencies need to be addressed before the application can be considered complete and filed:

1. Notice Requirements: Pursuant to Rule 5.1.2(m) the prospector shall send a notice to the local boards of County Commissioners in the counties where the proposed prospecting activities occur. Also, the prospector shall certify that such notice was submitted. Please send notice to the Mineral County Board of County Commissioners and provide the Division with a copy of said notice, as well as a certified mail receipt or some other form of trackable delivery.

Per Rule 5.3.1(b) the applicant shall address all identified deficiencies within 60 days of the date of this notice. Please submit your responses to the above listed items no later than Wednesday May 25, 2022. If your response nor a written request for an extension is not received by May 25, 2022 your application may be denied.
