In reading of the Minerals Program Inspection Report conducted on December 16, 2021, I noticed that the applicant had complied with Rule 1.6.2(b) by publishing notice 4 consecutive weeks, the last date being November 24, 2021. I also noted no letters of opposing were presented by the December 14, 2021 deadline. Several letters opposing the project have been presented after the deadline. I did not see any documentation of the notices and where they were published in the report or in the online file for the permit. Obviously this documentation had to be presented in order for the inspector to reach the conclusion that the requirement had been satisfied. I have reached out personally to Stephine Fancher-English to help all parties concerned to have a less contentious relationship. I am wondering if you could also verify where these notices were published so that the process could be more transparent and that any parties opposed can let their voices be heard within the rules?
