## RE: Notice of Completeness, SO-01 Wyman Pit, File No. M-1983-037

Dear Mr. Wyman,

On April 12, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your Application for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operator for the Wyman Pit, Permit M-1983-037. The Division finds this application complete for filing and has no additional adequacy items at this time.

Please Note:

- 1. The Division conducted a sight inspection on December 2, 2021. The inspection resulted in surety increase (SI-2) to the operator. SI-2 was approved by the Division on January 14, 2022.
- 2. It is presumed that you have a copy of all the permit materials and suggest that you keep a copy of the permit and the permit application at the mining operation as a reference for operational personnel, to help ensure compliance with terms of the permit.
- 3. Changes in the mining and reclamation operation that differ from those described in the permit may require a modification to the permit. We suggest consulting the Rules and Regulations and/or contacting us to determine if a modification to the permit it necessary. Rule 1.10 pertains to Amendments, Rule 1.9 to Technical Revisions, and Rule 1.11 to Conversions.
- 4. On your permit anniversary date each year, you must submit an annual fee and annual report to us. Please consult the Rule, Act, and your permit for specific requirements.
