Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association Inc. (Tri-State), is the parent company to Axial Basin Coal Company, which is the general partner to Colowyo Coal Company L.P. (Colowyo). Therefore, Tri-State on behalf of Colowyo is submitting this adequacy response for minor revision 240 (MR-240) to Permit No. C-1981-019.

Tri-State received the Division's adequacy letter dated April 25, 2022, and has the following responses to the Division's concerns:

1. The Division has performed a reclamation cost estimate to reclaim the additional topsoil stripping at the Collom Pit area. The total value of this estimate is \$408,354.00 (see attached cost estimate). The Division's cost estimate is consistent with previous cost estimates approved by both the Division and Colowyo. The Division respectfully requests a response from Colowyo with any questions regarding the cost estimate or an acceptable of the Division's estimate.

Response: Tri-State on behalf of Colowyo has reviewed the Division's reclamation cost estimate, and hereby provides concurrence with the Division increase in reclamation liability for MR-240.
