**Re: Bowie No. 1 Mine, Permit C-1981-38,
Initial review of the 2021 ARR, with focus on the ARR form**

Dear Mr. Bear:

On February 15, 2022, the Division received BRL's 2021 Annual Reclamation Report (ARR). I have the following issues regarding the ARR form:

1. The values in the left column in the 2021 ARR must match the values in the right column of the ARR from the previous year (2020).
2. Per the supporting text in the ARR, 17.11 acres were reseeded in 2011, and these acres should be added to the 10 years category and subtracted from the less than 10 year category.
3. The additional Phase III value for 2021 should be 10.38 acres, not 13.38. Also, 0.51 acres should be added for Phase II. These values are based on the final released acreage values from bond release SL-07.

I have included a revised ARR form with the updated acreages. Please let me know if you agree or disagree with my edits. As always, call or e-mail me with any questions related to this review, and/or submit a formal response via the Division's ePermitting system.
