Dear Mr. Oliver,

Thank you for investigating the Division's concerns related to groundwater level monitoring data since August 2018. After a review of Brannan's March 2 and April 6, 2022 responses and the latest groundwater level monitoring data for the 1st quarter 2022, DRMS maintains the position that potential mounding behind the slurry wall since the repair to the leak in 2018 exists. However, due to the fact that the adjacent site, Sandy Acres, is currently working on approved mitigation, DRMS will continue to monitor the quarterly groundwater level data at Pit 29 prior to a final determination as to the impact, if any, to the hydrologic balance. If the increasing trend of groundwater levels above current or historic levels continues, additional mitigation may be required.
