On May 12, 2022 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from Rio Blanco County to IHC Scott, Inc., for the Picenace Pit, Permit M-2001-077. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Financial Warranty

1. Afidavit of Autorotiy signed on behalf of Terri Priday at IHC Scott, Inc. otherwise bonding is complete. See Attached form.

Legal Right of Enter

2. Provide a description of the basis for legal right of entry to the site and to conduct mining and reclamation. See Construction Materials Rules 6.3.7, 6.4.14, and 1.6.2(1)(e)(i). This may be a copy of an access lease, deed, abstract of title, current tax receipt, or a signed and notarized statement by the property owners stating that the Prospective Successor has a legal right to enter.

Structure Agreement

3. Provide the Division copies of agreements to compensate the owners of any significant, valuable, and permanent man-made structures and utilities within 200 feet of the affected land ("Structure Agreements"). See attached from. If none, include a statement of such.
