- (b) until the bond is released pursuant to 30 CFR §800.40, replaced in accordance with 30 CFR §800.30, or until the permit has been sold, reassigned or otherwise transferred in accordance with 30 CFR §774.17; and
- (c) for a minimum period of 5 years, notwithstanding the requirements of subparagraphs (a) and (b) above, it being further understood that if the Principal performs any augmented seeding, fertilization or other supplemental reclamation work on the site prior to bond release, the period of liability under this bond shall begin again subject to the exception found in 30 CFR §816.116(c)(4) or 30 CFR §817.116(c)(4).


