## Re: Mountain Coal Company, LLC, West Elk Mine; Permit No. C-1980-007; Minor Revision No. MR-466 Concrete Pad at Shaft 1 for additional rock dust storage

Dear Mr. Simmons:

Mountain Coal Company, LLC (MCC) submits this letter, location images, pad drawing and application form for Minor Revision No. 466 to add a concrete pad at Shaft 1 to hold a rock dust silo. The silo will be used for additional rock dust storage. MCC will relocate the existing inactive rock dust silo from the Portal to Shaft 1. There are two possibilities for the location of the concrete pad at Shaft 1. Reasoning for the two location possibilities is due to the location of buried utilities and drains and size of equipment that may be used to construct the pad. See attached images for location options. In either pad location scenario, the amount of concrete used to construct the pad will be the same.

The storage silo is to increase storage capacity at Shaft 1 only. The silo will not contain a bag house. MCC will remain at the same usage limits to comply with air quality standards.

The pad will be constructed of approximately 79 cubic yards of concrete.
