OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Jake Wilkinson, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Gold Links Mine is located approximately 4.7 miles north of Ohio City and accessed from CR 771. The site is a 110(2) operation that includes a total of 6.2 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$8,598.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is adequate. The landowner has requested that all mine related buildings and structures remain intact after reclamation. Because of this, there is little reclamation work remaining to be completed at the site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The site consists of a portal secured with a locked steel gate and a waste rock bench. Avalanche roofing and ventilation system have been installed outside the portal. Several outbuildings are located on the mine bench. Equipment and materials at the site are stored in an orderly fashion throughout the bench area. Fuel stored on site was located in adequate secondary containment.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
