The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has reviewed the June 8, 2022 DOE Reclamation Bond Estimate Report – Revision 2 for the Burros Mine. Per the 2015 DOE/DRMS Memorandum of Understanding, DOE is the lead bonding authority for operations on DOE lease tracts, but consults with DRMS on the sufficiency of the bond amount. The Division has reviewed the estimate and concurs that bond in the amount of \$12,560.18 would be sufficient to complete reclamation at the site.
