FMIC Ditch Slope Stability Monitoring Report Submittal Schedule**

Dear Mr. Webster,

The June 15, 2022 submittal of the monthly Slope Stability Monitoring Report indicated the final lift of fill material has been placed to buttress the slope between the FMIC ditch and the new wash pond (reference TR-5). As such, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) considers the construction phase of this project complete. Pursuant to the commitment made by Aggregate Industries in the November 23, 2020 letter, the long term monitoring and reporting phase for the stability of the buttressed slope should begin next month according to the following schedule:

Year 1	Monthly	15 th of July 2022 through 15 th of June 2023
Year 2	Quarterly	9/15/2023, 12/12/2023, 3/15/2024, 6/15/2024
Year 3	Bi-Annual	December 15, 2024 and June 15, 2025
Final Report	One time	July 15, 2025
