

Technical Revision for M-1980-205 located at 17269 County Road 12 in Fort Lupton Colorado

Operator: Leister Materials Limited DBA Select Materials

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Site Plan for the parcels 39 acres:

1. Attached Map light Blue shaded area of 15 acres is in its final configuration as a materials laydown area and shop.
2. Attached Map light Green shaded area of 10.9 acres is in agricultural use as per our USR for materials processing. Our firm produces wood fines to compost dairy manure at TV dairy in Fort Lupton and other sites for use in our soil mixes. The stick we process for composting of manure is required to eliminate the manure for agricultural purposes and then the final compost is shipped back to our site for soil materials processing. No prep work is required for this area as it is already flat and in materials processing use.
3. Attached Map non shaded area on 13.1 acres is in mining use. The plan is to mine at a 2:1 slope with perimeter property edges mined at a 3:1 slope. Site slopes will be reclaimed with 4-6 inches of topsoil that will be maintained on site. Current location is east of the shop building by approximately 100 yards. Reclaimed soil will be seeded with rye or other grazing grass. The inner portion of the property will stay in mining production until it is converted to additional laydown area or additional agricultural materials processing area. All area currently not mined has rye grass on it and is used to feed our animals that are either on the site or on our adjoining fenced non-mine site to the west of the mine site.
