1. It is the Division's understanding that the applicant will not apply for a stormwater detention

permit but will allow any stormwater to infiltrate into the ground and if there is ponding for longer

than 72 hours then the applicant will eliminate the ponding areas. Please confirm this is the case or

provide an alternate narrative.

This is correct. We will not apply for a stormwater detention permit. We will allow any stormwater to infiltrate the ground, and any areas that pond longer than 72 hours will be eliminated.

2. It is the Division's understanding that the applicant will not be leaving an exposed shale floor and is

planning on spreading overburden over the floor and seeding it with the NRCS recommended

seeding mixture. Please confirm this is the case or provide an alternate narrative.

This is correct. We will not be leaving the shale floor exposed, we will cover the shale floor with overburden and reseed using the recommendation received from the NRCS office.

3. The Division has attached to this review its Reclamation Cost Estimate for the site. Please review

the estimate and provide any comments, as this amount will be the required financial warranty

amount for the site.

We have reviewed the reclamation cost estimate amount of \$17,315 and agree that this is an adequate amount, and agree to that amount being needed in the form of financial warranty.
