Dear Mr. Icabone:

On June 24, 2022, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your Notice of Intent to Conduct Prospecting Operations (NOI) for the project known as Wilson Placer Reclamation NOI and assigned it File No. P-2022-012. The NOI application lists 1.92 acre as the total project area to be disturbed. As stated in section VII. of the NOI application form, a financial warranty must be filed in the amount of \$2,000.00 per acre for land disturbed pursuant to Rule 5.3.3. Your NOI application did not contain a financial warranty in the amount of \$4,000.00, therefore your NOI is incomplete and the Division will not conduct a technical review of the NOI until the financial warranty is submitted and accepted by the Division. **Be advised that if the \$4,000.00 financial warranty is not submitted and accepted by the Division within 60 days of the date of this letter, due on or before August 30, 2022, the Division may terminate the NOI application.** This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no technical deficiencies in the NOI application as a technical review has not been conducted at this time.
