Mr. Hamarat:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) conducted an inspection on May 27, 2022 to investigate a complaint (CT1) against the Henderson Mine. During the inspection, Henderson committed to submit the water samples from locations WRF-20 and WFR-40 on the Williams Fork River taken on May 16, 2022 as evidence the high wind event did not affect the water quality in the river.

The Division reviewed the water quality data submitted on July 20, 2022 and agrees the data collected in May is within historical normal ranges for all parameters.
