On August 11, 2022 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on May 27, 2022, addressing the following:

Update the Mining Plan to include:

- 1. Phased mining approach, increasing the maximum allowed disturbed area at one time to 40 acres.
- 2. Processing and stockpile areas.
- 3. Stormwater management.
- 4. A blasting plan, prepared by our mining contractor, to help minimize potential impact to Highway 115.
- 5. Updated Mining Plan Maps,

The terms of Technical Revision No. 3 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1997-064. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1997-064 remain in full force and effect.
