Dear Nick Bellino:

On August 17, 2022 the Mined Land Reclamation Board (MLRB) considered your request for a second five-year period of Temporary Cessation for the Ranch Land Rock Pit #1, further described as:

Notice of 2nd 5-Year Period of Temporary Cessation beginning July 20, 2022.

The decision reached by the Mined Land Reclamation Board is: Approve.

Please be aware that in accordance with Rule 1.13.9, in no case shall Temporary Cessation be continued for more than ten (10) years without terminating the mining operation and fully complying with the Reclamation requirements of the Act and the Rules.

In accordance with Rule 1.13.8, the permit for Ranch Land Rock Pit #1 shall continue in effect as long as mining operations resume within five years of the beginning of Temporary Cessation or the Operator files a request for an extension of the period of Temporary Cessation with the Board meeting the requirements of Rule 1.13.5(3) and secures Board approval of that request, as done by the MLRB today.
