

PUBLIC NOTICE

Grand Junction Pipe & Supply Co.; 556 Struthers Ave (970)242-5370, has filed an application for a Regular (112) Construction Materials Operation Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials. The proposed mine is known as the Delta Paving Gravel Pit, and is located at or near Section 10, Township 15 North, Range 95 West of the Colorado Principal Meridian.

The proposed date of commencement is May 2023, and the proposed date of completion is October 2040. The proposed future use of the land is rangeland.
