Board of Chaffee County Commissioners,

This letter is to inform Counties and Municipalities within two miles of a mining operation of the intent of the Operator to put their mining operation into a state of Temporary Cessation. This letter is sent pursuant to the requirements of Rule 1.13.6 of the Construction Materials Rules of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board.

Please Be advised that Pete Lein & Sons, Inc., Whose address is P.O. Box 440, Rapid City, SD 57709 and whose telephone number is (605)-342-7224, has filed Notice of Temporary Cessation with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety for the Newett Quarry located in Chaffee County on lands administered by the U.S. Forest Service. The period of Temporary Cessation will commence beginning on January 1, 2022 and will last up to five years from that date, ending January 1, 2027. The Notice of Temporary Cessation will be considered by the Mined Land Reclamation Board and has been placed on the regular agenda for the September 21-22, 2022 Board meeting. During that meeting the Board will consider whether or not to accept the Notice.
