## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The Hess Pit is located approximately ten miles south of Durango and accessed from Dos Rios Road. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.0 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$34,641.06 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by the access road on the west and south, and slopes and berms on the north and east.

Mining was not occurring during this inspection. Slopes on the north end of the pit have been mostly graded to 2H:1V. Vegetation is becoming established on the slopes, consisting mostly of volunteer native species. Various equipment is located on the pit floor. Only small stockpiles of gravel were located on site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
