OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The AGRI-DLD Gravel Pit is located approximately 9.5 miles southeast of Durango and accessed from CR 307. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 156.27 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$142,062.19 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

Roughly 20 acres are currently disturbed at the site. The disturbance area is currently within the Phase 1-3 areas. A batch plant is located in the Phase 1 "Staging Area". Mining was not occurring during this inspection. Gravel stockpiles are located throughout the pit area. Topsoil and overburden stockpiles were observed within the pit. Mining appears to be progressing to the south from the Phase 2 area into the Phase 3 area. The various sections of highwall observed appeared stable. No erosional concerns were noted.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
