OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The Hocker Gravel Pit is located approximately 2.8 miles southeast of Ignacio and accessed from Hwy 151. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 81.7 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$26,676.00 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the east entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Mining was not occurring during this inspection. Conditions at the site are similar to the Division's last inspection. There is a vertical highwall on the east side of the Phase 1 / Phase 2 area, approximately 400 lineal feet and 25 feet high. Backfill material is stockpiled near the highwall for reclamation. Slopes in the Phase 3 area have been reduced and additional overburden material is available in this area for reclamation. Construction debris has been placed in the pit area for burial as approved by TR-01 in 2011. Overburden and topsoil stockpiles were located throughout the site. Several small piles of crushed gravel remain on site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
