## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The Boullion King Mine Reclamation Project is located approximately seven miles west of Crested Butte and accessed from Lake Irwin Road, about 0.75 miles above Lake Irwin. The site is a 110(2) "reclamation only" operation (MLRB Order December 17, 2018, M-2016-071, MV-2017-048) that covers a 7.63 acre affected area. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$10,000.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Reclamation work has commenced at the site. The waste rock piles have been shaped to final grade. The discharge pipe has been sealed and the ponds have been filled in and shaped to final grade. All grading appears adequate and in compliance with the approved Reclamation Plan. It did not appear that seeding had taken place yet. Vegetation is not yet established in the reclamation area. Noxious weed infestations were not noted.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
