INSPECTION TOPIC: Availability Of Records

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: Mining has not occurred at the site since 2007. The operation was not placed into Temporary Cessation and final reclamation has not commenced. Pursuant to Rule 1.13.5, an Operator must file a Notice of Temporary Cessation (TC) if the mining operation temporarily ceases production for 180 days or more. Pursuant to Rule 1.13.9, TC cannot be continued for more than 10 years. Production at this site has not occurred for over 10 years. Therefore, the Operator must commence final reclamation. Pursuant to Rule 3.1.3, all reclamation must be completed within 5 years.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Notify the Division, in writing, of the Operators proposed schedule for completing reclamation at the site. The schedule must comply with 5 year time limit pursuant to Rule 3.1.3.

OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the Operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate conditions observed.

The High Flume Gravel Pit is located approximately 11.5 miles south of Durango and accessed from Rancho Durango Road. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 43.06 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$72,645.00 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

Mining has not occurred at this site since 2007. Consequently, the access road is extremely eroded. The inspector was unable to access the pit area due to the unpassable condition of the access road. Pursuant to Rule 1.13.5, an Operator must file a Notice of Temporary Cessation (TC) if the mining operation temporarily ceases production for 180 days or more. The Operator did not file a Notice of Temporary Cessation at the time production ceased. Pursuant to Rule 1.13.9, in no case can TC be continued for more than 10 years. Therefore, the Operator must commence final reclamation. Pursuant to Rule 3.1.3, all reclamation must be completed within 5 years. This has been noted as a problem on page one of this report.

Most of the dilapidated equipment has been removed from the scalehouse area. The scale and scalehouse remain on site.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.


