### **Exhibits Previously Permitted**

The following Exhibits are not changing due to this amendment application: A, B, C, D, G, H, I, J, K, M, O, P and S. These exhibits are a part of the original application package dated September 30, 1983 or updated via one of the four approved Technical Revisions listed below. There are five recorded Technical Revisions to this permit. TR04 was withdrawn. TR01 added a wash plant to the mining operation. TR02 put the site into a Temporary Cessation, TR03 expanded the operation by 10 acres, TR05 allowed for the onsite berms to remain during reclamation activities. TR05 will no longer be pertinent due to the new reclamation plan which will remove all berms and reclaim for residential use. Attached are the proof of notification to the El Paso County Commissioners, El Paso County Conservation District, and El Paso County Clerk & Record to update Exhibits Q and R.

### 6.4.5 Exhibit E

### **Reclamation Plan**

Reclamation to residential use will occur following mining at the site. Topsoil, waste rock, overburden and onsite berms will be utilized for reclamation. Throughout mined area, slopes will be graded at a 3H:1V or flatter. Waste rock and overburden will be placed on the pit floor as quantity allows. Four to six inches of topsoil will be replaced on affected surfaces. If necessary, surfaces will be roughened prior to cover seeding.

Turkey Canon Quarry LLC will use the seed mix below if needed to stabilize soils prior to residential building begins. The seed will be drilled at  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  in depth and straw mulch will be crimped in.

All mining structures, including interior haul roads and stormwater diversion structures, will be reclaimed following all mining operations.

Throughout the mining area, salvageable surface material will be used in final reclamation. Upon commencement of reclamation, the area will be monitored for noxious weeds. Turkey Canon Quarry LLC implement appropriate methods to manage weed growth and will work with the El Paso County Weed Control Program for recommendations in the event noxious weeds develop.

Enclosed is the proposed drainage map showing how the material from the berms will be used to establish the grade. Onsite material is estimated to be sufficient for all reclamation activities with no need to import materials.

Additionally, the residential land use concept maps are provided for additional information. Entech Engineering, Inc. has also provided a letter with their analysis of the berm removal process for final reclamation purposes. Their analysis indicates that no adjacent properties will be impacted due to this activity. A detailed reclamation cost estimation is attached for review.
