Dear Mr. Marcus,

On June 30, 2022, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received a request for Technical Revision (TR-17) to describe the CKD material handling plan and associated dust control measures at the Lyons Quarry, Permit No. M-1977-208. The TR was submitted in response to a problem citation during the March 2022 inspection that was conducted in response to a complaint received by the Division. On September 30, 2022 the Operator responded to the Division's Preliminary Adequacy Review dated July 7, 2022. After review of the responses the Division has an additional item(s) that need to be addressed or clarified. Please respond to the adequacy items with a letter summarizing each response, to the numbered items below, in a cover letter titled "Adequacy Review No. 2 Response TR-17, M-1977-208".

1. The map provided in the response has a mapped date 8/22/22. Does this date correspond to a new drone flight image from what was submitted in the original technical revision application? If a new image has been used please provide the new image for review and comparison purposes.
2. Please provide an explanation of the "temporary cap" areas located in the middle of the "not currently capped" area. These areas were not previously identified in the original submittal.
3. Submit an extension request for the decision date upon receipt of this letter.

This concludes the Division's adequacy review no. 2 of your technical revision. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

Please allow the Division sufficient time to complete its review by submitting your response **no later than five (5) working days prior to the decision date**. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date. If on the decision date,



outstanding adequacy items remain, and no extension request has been received, your revision may be denied and the file terminated.
