CRG Mining LLC, 510 S. Wisconsin St., Gunnison, CO 81230, 970-641-3450, has filed an application for an amendment to its Hard Rock/Metal Mining Limited Impact (110) Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act. The permitted mine is known as the Upper Gold Links Mine, and is located at or near Section 31, Township 51N, Range 4E, 10th Prime Meridian.

The proposed date of commencement is September 2022, and the proposed date of completion is September 2042. The proposed future use of the land is forestry.
