On October 9, 2022, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your request for an extension for Permit Application decision date. The decision date has been extended from October 11, 2022 to November 11, 2022.

The Permit Application is under a Board order and needs to have all materials approvable within the statutory deadline of 365 days from when the application was filed (Rule 1.4.1(9)). The Permit Application was filed on July 13, 2022 and must be approved by July 12, 2023. If additional review time is needed beyond the July 12, 2023 deadline, the matter will be set for a Board hearing (Rule 1.4.1(9)).
